A BILL TO AMEND THE ELECTRIC POWER
TAXATION ACT

NOTE

This Bill amends *The Electric Power Taxation Act*, being chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942.

While the aforementioned Act is one in which the tax thereunder is suspended for the duration of the Dominion-Provincial Taxation Agreement 1952-1957, it is nonetheless a subsisting Act and the amendments made thereto by this Bill are for the purposes of having this Act conform to *The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act* in respect of appeals from assessment and taxation. Appeals from assessment and taxation to the Board of Public Utility Commissioners are being abolished and appeals are to be made to the Alberta Assessment Commission. The amendments to this Act correct the references in section 3 to the body to which such appeals are to be made.

This Bill comes into force on the 1st day of July, 1953.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Electric Power Taxation Act*, being chapter 44 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942, is hereby amended.

2. Section 3 is amended

(a) by striking out the words "Board of Public Utility Commissioners", where they occur in subsection (4), and by substituting the words "Alberta Assessment Commission";

(b) by striking out subsection (5) and by substituting the following:

"(5) All the provisions of *The Alberta Municipal Assessment Commission Act*, so far as they are not in conflict with this Act, apply to assessments and appeals under this Act.";

(c) by striking out the words "Board of Public Utility Commissioners", where they occur in subsection (6), and by substituting the words "Alberta Assessment Commission".

3. This Act comes into force on the first day of July, 1953.
