AN ACT TO AMEND THE SCHOOL ACT

(Assented to

, 1983)

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1 The School Act is amended by this Act.
- 2 The following is added after section 147:
 - **147.1** Subject to sections 149 and 150 every school shall operate on 200 days in each school year.
- 3 Section 148(1)(b) is repealed and the following is substituted:
 - (b) subject to section 147.1, specify the days of school operation.
- 4 This Bill comes into force on July 1, 1983.

Explanatory Notes

- 1 This Bill will amend chapter S-3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.
- 2 Provides for 200 days of operation for every school.
- **3** Section 148(1)(b) presently reads:
 - 148(1) A board shall
 - (b) specify the number and the days of school operation.
- 4 Coming into force.
